Instructions for the Reference:

The above identified individual has applied for service with the Missioners of Christ, a non-profit Catholic Community/Apostolate, as an extended-term missionary (approximately 2 years) in Honduras. He/She has listed you as a reference for consideration in this ministry.

We want to begin by sharing that the missionary life in Honduras is very intense and difficult. The life within the Missioners of Christ Community is very much akin to that of a religious order (and we frequently work side by side with various local religious orders). The greatest challenges most individuals find in this area is submission to authority, adapting to a completely foreign country and world-view, dealing with the suffering all around them along with the subsequent internal struggle and sense of helplessness due to the fact there is so little we can do, tangibly, to alleviate that suffering.

While there is much time devoted to personal prayer, there is little privacy. There are set times for prayer, meals, ministry, and such for each day, and much of the missionary's activity is dictated to them... which tends to be difficult for most western-culture adults to adapt to. And living day in and day out with other imperfect people who are having their own struggles can be stressful. In general, our experience has been that those who apply who have already had difficulties with anxiety and/or any form of depression, as well as those who are looking to this opportunity to "escape" a difficult life situation, relationship, or family life, do not fare well, and even can have their condition exacerbated by coming to the mission. For these reasons, we ask you to be as open and honest as possible regarding your perceived suitability of the applicant to participate in such a ministry. We feel our responsibility is not to choose the "best" (whatever that may mean) people for the mission, but to mutually discern to the best of our ability, those called to this particular ministry at this time in their lives.

Please address the areas identified on the bottom of this form. The reference you give is confidential, and will not be shared with the applicant. - * Would you recommend the applicant for this particular ministry at this particular time in their lives?

- * **Do you have any concerns with the applicant working with children?**
- * **Would you recommend the applicant for this particular ministry at this particular time in their lives?**
